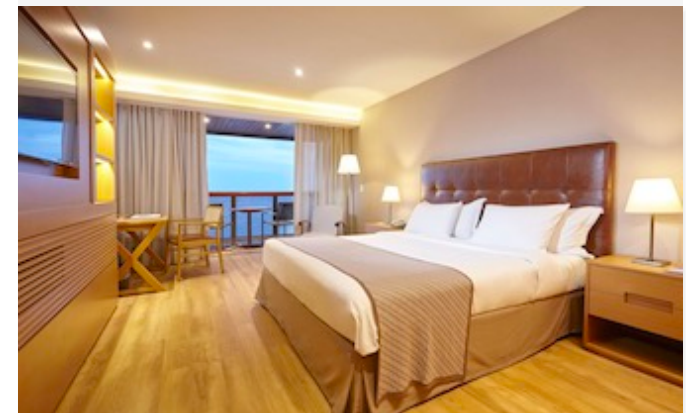
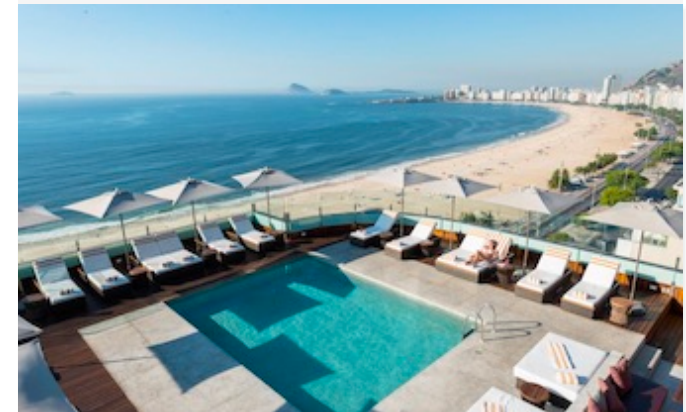

### RIO DE JANEIRO

#### FULL DAY SMALL GROUP TOUR OF THE 'MARVELLOUS CITY'

Today you will explore Rio, including two of the city's most iconic attractions, Christ the Redeemer and Sugar Loaf mountain, accompanied by one of our excellent local guides.

Start by driving along the beaches of Rio taking in the Rodrigo de Freitas lagoon. Pass through the Cosme Velho district before taking the cogwheel train up Corcovado mountain to a summit of 670 metres. To get to the very top you climb a final flight of steps to reach the base of the Christ the Redeemer Statue. This Art Nouveau classic is known the world over. Admire the amazing views of mountains, beaches and the Guanabara bay below. Stop for lunch.

After lunch you continue to the Sugar Loaf mountain for another picture postcard view of Rio. The summit is reached by a two stage cable car ride. The first cable car takes you to the Morro da Urca from where there are amazing views of Botafogo bay and the yacht club. The next stage takes you to the top of the Sugar Loaf for unrivalled views of the city.

After the tour you will be returned to your hotel by early evening.

## THE AMAZON

### MEETING OF THE WATERS & JOURNEY TO THE LODGE

Your day begins early this morning with pick up from your hotel around 06:30am - 07:30am. The journey to the lodge takes about 3 hours in total, first by speed boat, then by van and then another boat. A stop is made en route at the meeting of the waters which is where the brown coloured water of the Solimões river meets the black coloured water of the Negro River. Although the rivers meet here, the water runs side by side, instead of mixing. This is what forms the Amazon river itself. Once you arrive to Juma the staff will greet you with a welcome drink and some refreshing tropical fruit before lunch.

After lunch you will embark on a canoe tour of the Igarapés (Amazonian creeks) and the Igapós (the flooded forest). These places are only possible to visit by canoe. It is also possible to swim in the water here where you could encounter the famous pink dolphins! Dinner is served back at the lodge.

This evening you will take a boat trip after dark to see frogs, birds and caiman. The resident guide will use his torch in the darkness to try and catch the reflective eyes of the caiman! The guide can even catch the caiman and bring it into the boat for a closer look. After this the caiman is returned to the river unharmed.

## THE AMAZON

### SUNRISE EXCURSION, JUNGLE HIKE & PIRANHA FISHING!

Rise early this morning to experience the sun rising over the Amazon. Witness the beautiful colours and the sounds of the waking birds. The resident guides have binoculars on hand and will be able to point out different species of birds. Return to the lodge for a fresh breakfast before your next excursion.

Accompanied by one of the resident guides you will take a walk in the rainforest to learn about this important eco system and the thousands of different species of flora and fauna that inhabit it. Your guide will explain how the locals use the different plants for food and to cure illness. The path you take is changed constantly to avoid over using any one trail. Return to the lodge for lunch and some time to relax.

Later in the afternoon you will board a motorboat with the guide to go fishing for the infamous piranha as well as other native Amazonian fish! This relaxing activity is the perfect way to enjoy the sunset.

On returning to the lodge dinner will be provided by the fish that you caught earlier in the afternoon! After dinner one of the guides will offer an informal lecture on the ecology, culture and tradition of the Amazon region.

## THE AMAZON

### JUNGLE HIKE BEFORE A VISIT TO AN AMAZONIAN VILLAGE

Depart the lodge after breakfast for a hike into a different area of the forest accompanied by one of the resident guides. Along the way keep an eye out for many different animals such as monkeys and sloths. You will reach a clearing in the forest where lunch will be served in the traditional way, cooking over an open fire. There are some hammocks here where you can relax.

This afternoon visit a local village and learn about how the inhabitants of the Amazon live. One of the locals will share with you his knowledge of the traditional medicinal plants and how they are used on a daily basis. The villagers will also show you how to prepare manic flour which is one of the regions main crops and source of income. After some time here you will return to the lodge for dinner.

## THE PANTANAL

### JOURNEY BACK TO MANAUS & FLY ON TO CUIABA VIA PORTO VELHO

On the way back to Manaus there will be a stop at the Pirarucu Floating Dock to see the giant Pirarucu fish. From here you will return to Manaus in time for your flight to Porto Velho of 1 hour and 30 minutes followed by a connecting flight to Cuiaba of 1 hour and 30 minutes.

On arrival to the airport at Cuiaba you will be met by your guides and taken along with any other guests to the lodge. More than just a transfer, this trip down the Transpantaneira road is a fantastic photo safari and your first encounter with the myriad wildlife of the Pantanal.

The journey provides amazing views of the wildlife and stops are often made for photos. There is an English speaking guide in the vehicle who will offer some commentary along the way.

After settling into your room the guide will show you around the property with an introductory walk as well as a visit to the Great Egret Lookout which is a 12 metre high observation tower.

After dinner there is a short night walk where on a clear night you can admire the amazing display of stars.

## THE PANTANAL

### A DAY OF HIKING & CANOEING, HOWLER MONKEY TRAIL & A NIGHT DRIVE

After breakfast this morning take a photo safari along dirt roads travelling towards the Clarinho River. From here you will board a canoe to start paddling downstream and get a closer look at the forest and mangroves. Giant Otter families can sometimes be seen here playing in the water. You will also get to try fishing for the elusive Piranha!

Depending on the weather conditions a BBQ lunch will either be served on the riverbank in the shade of a tree or back at the lodge. There are hammocks here to enjoy a siesta. Return to the lodge in time for afternoon tea!

This afternoon you will walk the howler monkey trail that leads to the incredible, 25 metre high observation tower called the howler monkey tower! From here there is an amazing view of the sun setting over the Pantanal. Return to the lodge after dark in time for dinner.

After dinner you have the option to join a night drive to go looking for the Pantanal's more nocturnal animals!

**NOTE:** All your activities are included during your stay in the Pantanal. The exact itinerary of excursions may change subject to weather conditions and other factors.

## THE PANTANAL

### HORSE RIDING & HIKE THE RONDON TRAIL

This morning you will explore the Pantanal on horse back with a ride across the plains including some flooded areas. The local Pantaneiro horses are docile and friendly. In the Pantanal, an area of cattle ranches, they are a daily companion and means of transportation for the locals. Lead by an expert guide, this leisurely excursion is a fantastic way to immerse yourself in nature. Return to the lodge in time for lunch.

After lunch, spend the afternoon on a scenic hike along the Rondon trail that leads to the 13 metre high Jabiru Stork Tower. Here you can look into a Jabiru Stork nest and learn about these intriguing birds.

Return to the lodge in the afternoon for some free time before dinner. Perhaps enjoy a dip in the pool or a cold beer by the bar!

## THE PANTANAL

### A DAY OF JAGUAR SPOTTING!

After breakfast this morning you will depart the lodge and head towards the Cuiaba River at the end of the Transpantaneira road. It is about 115km away and takes about 2.5 hours. From here you will board one of the small boats for a 6 hour safari with the sole aim of finding Jaguars. The boat will explore the Cuiaba river, Piquiri, Three Brothers riverbanks, bays and channels.

A lunch box is included on board with fruits and sandwiches prepared by the lodge.

Return to the lodge by 5pm in time for dinner.

**NOTE:** The best chance of seeing the Jaguars is between July and October.

## **IGUASSU FALLS**

### **FLY ON TO IGUASSU FALLS VIA SAO PAULO**

After breakfast depart the lodge heading back along the Transpantaneira road and straight to the airport in Cuiaba for your flight to Sao Paulo which takes 2 hours and 15 minutes and will connect to the onward flight to Iguassu of 1 hour and 40 minutes.

On arrival to Iguazu you will be met and taken by private transfer to your hotel. Evening at leisure.

The Iguassu waterfalls are one of the largest and most magnificent in the world. The word Iguassu comes from the native Guarani language which means “great water.” Located on the Iguassu river at the border of Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay, the majority of the falls are located on the Argentine side and the rest in Brazil. There are a total of several hundred individual falls along a 2 mile stretch of cliff and the thunderous roar can be heard from miles away. A real spectacle!

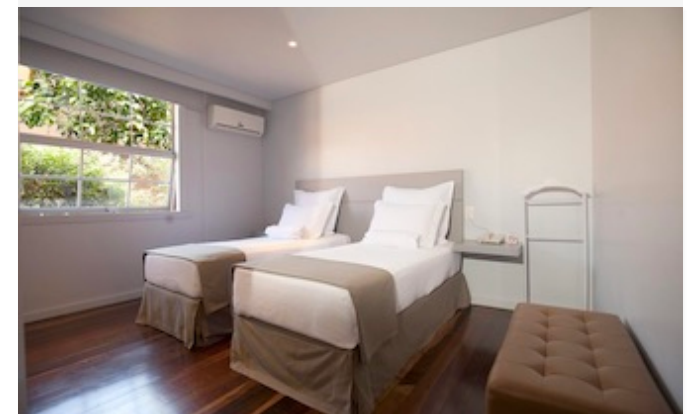

## DAY 13

DATE TBC

### IGUASSU FALLS

#### TOUR OF THE ARGENTINE FALLS INCLUDING BOAT RIDE TO THE BASE

You will be picked up early at your hotel in an air conditioned minibus and greeted by your local guide. You will be driven across the border into Argentina (don't forget your passport!) to catch the jungle train. The train travels slowly through the thick jungle and is a great opportunity to spot wildlife. On arrival there are some walkways that lead to a balcony looking right over the Devil's Throat and with panoramic views of the entire Devil's Gorge, one of the most spectacular parts of the falls. You will have plenty of time to walk the 800 metres of paths on the upper circuit. The paths are suspended to protect the vegetation and prevent disruption to the natural trails. This higher circuit affords fantastic views. The lower circuit has 600 metres of walkways with impressive views from below and around the falls.

This afternoon begins with an exciting open top truck ride through the jungle along the 8km Yacaratiá trail as your guide informs you about the trails and what to expect on the boat. On arrival to the port there are about 100 steps to get down to the river. From here you will board the motorboats that take you up the lower Iguazú rapids to the heart of the falls. You are given a waterproof bag for your camera because after the photo opportunities you will head right up to the falls. Be prepared to get very wet!

**TOP TIP:** For the boat trip there is an area where you can dry off but you may want to take some spare clothes and a towel in your day pack for extra comfort.

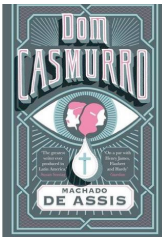
**THE VIOLENT LAND**

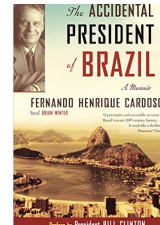

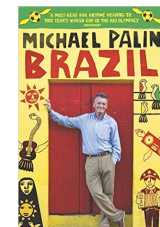
