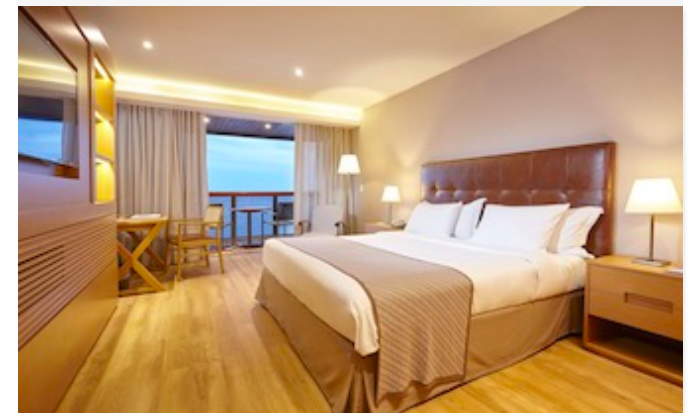
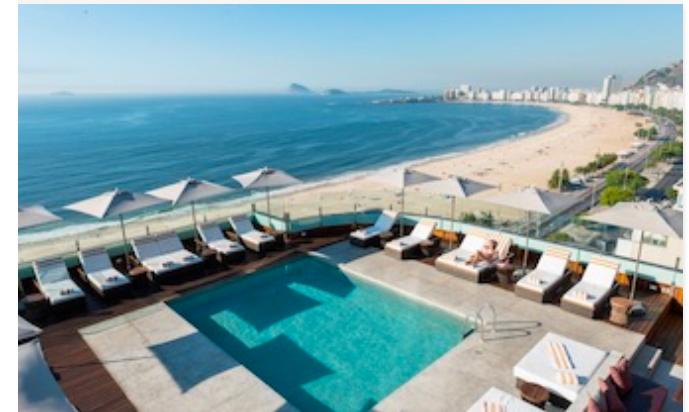

RIO DE JANEIRO

AN EXHILARATING OPEN TOP JEEP TOUR OF RIO

Spend a full day exploring four of Rio's most iconic sites by open top jeep! You will visit the Tijuca Atlantic Forest, the largest urban forest in the world, for breathtaking views of Copacabana, Ipanema, Guanabara Bay and Niterói. After visiting the national park the jeep continues up Corcovado mountain where the famous Christ the Redeemer statue is located, one of the most recognizable images of Rio. From the foot of the statue there are particularly good views of the Copacabana, Leblon and Ipanema beaches, the Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon and the Botanical Gardens.

After this it's time for lunch at a local restaurant before heading back out in the jeep to Sugar Loaf Mountain. Rising up from a small peninsular at the entrance to Guanabara Bay, the name of the mountain refers to its resemblance to a loaf of refined sugar. There are two cable cars, the first one taking you to the top of Urca Hill providing cinematic views of the bay. The second cable car goes up to the very top of the Sugar Loaf with 360 degree panoramic views of the entire city. The day finishes with a visit to the botanical garden, founded by Dom João VI, the king of Portugal, in 1808 as a place to acclimatize spices like nutmeg, pepper and cinnamon imported from the West Indies. Now an important research institute for botanical studies the beautiful gardens contain more than 6000 species of tropical and sub-tropical plants including 900 varieties of palm trees. There are also many rare species such as the Victoria-regia tree which is almost extinct. The exquisite and tranquil gardens were often visited by Tom Jobim and it is the perfect way to end the day before being dropped back at your hotel.

IGUAZU

FLY WEST TO THE SPECTACULAR IGUAZU FALLS

Private transfer from your hotel to the airport for your flight to Iguazu which takes 2 hours 15 minutes.

On arrival to the airport you will be met and taken by private transfer to your hotel.

This afternoon you will be picked up from your hotel by your guide and taken to the national park to enjoy the falls from the Brazilian side. From the different balconies there are spectacular views of the Argentine side of the falls, the lower Iguazu river and the Devil's Gorge Canyon. This side gives a fantastic perspective on the falls.

There is also a shopping and restaurant area for refreshments. After the tour you will dropped back at your hotel. The rest of the afternoon is at leisure to relax in your hotel.

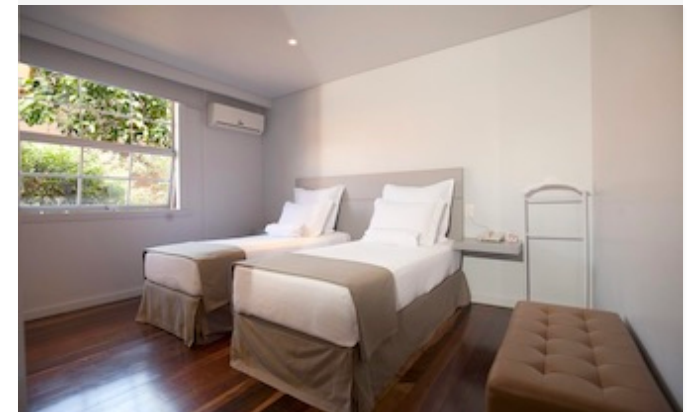

IGUASSU FALLS

A PRIVATE FULL DAY TOUR OF THE ARGENTINE SIDE OF THE FALLS

You will be picked up after breakfast at your hotel in an air conditioned minibus by your private local guide. You will be driven across the border and into Argentina (don't forget your passport!) to the train station for the jungle train. The train travels slowly through the thick jungle and is a great opportunity to spot wildlife. On arrival there are some walkways that lead to a balcony looking right over the Devil's Throat and with panoramic views of the entire Devil's Gorge, one of the most spectacular parts of the falls. You will have plenty of time to walk the 800 metres of paths on the upper circuit accompanied by your private guide. The paths are suspended to protect the vegetation and prevent disruption to the natural trails. This higher circuit affords fantastic views. The lower circuit has 600 metres of walkways with impressive views from below and around the falls.

This afternoon begin with an exciting open top truck ride through the jungle along the 8km Yacaratiá trail as your guide informs you about the trails and what to expect on the boat. On arrival to the port there are about 100 steps to get down to the river. From here you will board the motorboats that take you up the lower Iguazú rapids to the heart of the falls. You are given a waterproof bag for your camera because after the photo opportunities you will head right up to the falls. Be prepared to get very wet!

TOP TIP: For the boat trip there is an area where you can dry off but you may want to take some spare clothes and a towel in your day pack for extra comfort.

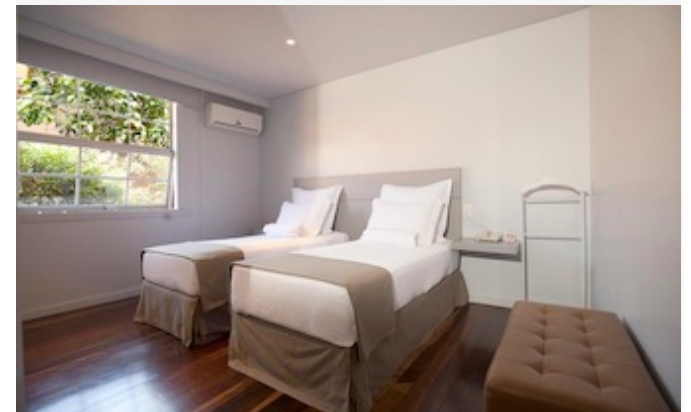

FLY BACK TO RIO & TRANSFER TO THE BEACH AT BUZIOS

Private transfer from your hotel to the airport for your flight to Rio which takes just under 2 hours.

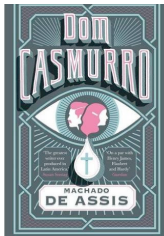
THE VIOLENT LAND

Machado de Assis is considered one of the founding fathers of Brazilian literature. This book first published in 1900 is widely regarded as a masterpiece of realist literature. Available in English it is a good read for the literary minded!

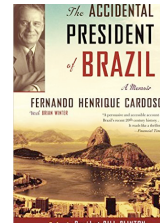

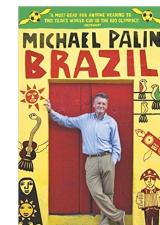
THROUGH THE BRAZILIAN WILDERNESS
