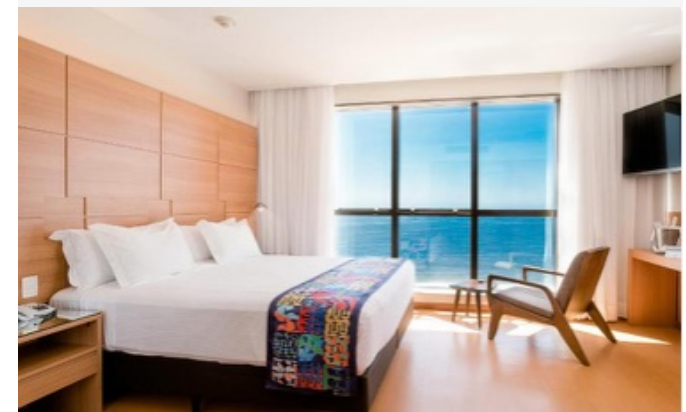

## RIO DE JANEIRO

### FULL DAY TOUR OF THE 'MARVELLOUS CITY' WITH A LOCAL GUIDE

Today you will explore Rio, including two of the city's most iconic attractions, Christ the Redeemer and Sugar Loaf mountain, accompanied by one of our excellent local guides. Start by driving along the beaches of Rio taking in the Rodrigo de Freitas lagoon. Pass through the Cosme Velho district before taking the cogwheel train up Corcovado mountain to a summit of 670 metres. To get to the very top you climb a final flight of steps to reach the base of the Christ the Redeemer Statue.

This Art Nouveau classic is known the world over. Admire the amazing views of mountains, beaches and the Guanabara bay below. Stop for lunch.

After lunch you continue to the Sugar Loaf mountain for another picture postcard view of Rio. The summit is reached by a two stage cable car ride. The first cable car takes you to the Morro da Urca from where there are amazing views of Botafogo bay and the yacht club. The next stage takes you to the top of the Sugar Loaf for unrivalled views of the city.

After the tour you will be returned to your hotel by early evening.

#### SHUTTLE TRANSFER TO CHARMING PARATY

You will see how Paraty is quite different from all the other colonial cities in Brazil, its architecture is unique with original 18th century characteristics. This is a great tour for people looking to film and take photos of Paraty's lovely colonial buildings.

Serving as an important port to transport the gold to Rio and then to Portugal the town flourished. Nowadays artists, chef's and bohemian types have moved in and relaxation is the order of the day!

The quiet, pedestrianised cobblestone centre with its white washed buildings and quaint churches is the perfect place to wander on foot whilst the best beaches and untouched islands are reached by boat.

## IGUAZU FALLS

### FREE TIME BEFORE TRANSFERRING BACK TO RIO TO FLY TO IGUAZU

Free time today before an after private transfer from your hotel to the airport in Rio for your evening flight to Iguassu.

On arrival in Iguassu you will have a private transfer the short distance to your hotel to overnight.

The Iguazu waterfalls are one of the largest and most magnificent in the world. The word Iguazu comes from the native Guarani language which means “great water.” Located on the Iguazu river at the border of Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay, the majority of the falls are located on the Argentine side and the rest in Brazil.

There are a total of several hundred individual falls along a 2 mile stretch of cliff and the thunderous roar can be heard from miles away. A real spectacle!

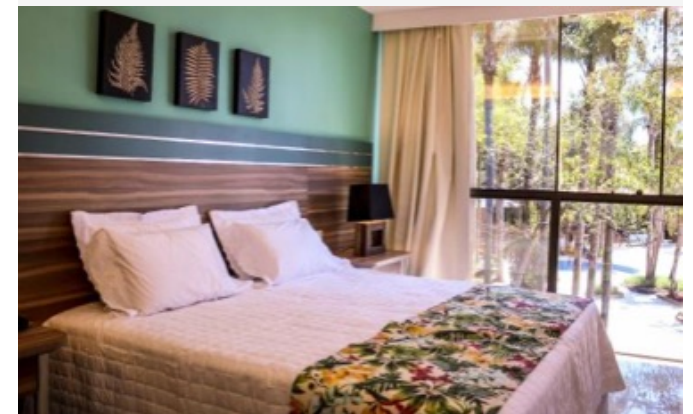

## **IGUAZU FALLS**

### **HALF DAY TOUR OF THE BRAZILIAN SIDE OF THE FALLS**

Pick up at the hotel and head towards the Iguazu National Park in Brazil. En route to the falls, we will drive through the lush, subtropical vegetation of the park. After arrival, we will take a descending trail of the canyon, from where we can enjoy panoramic views of more than 240 falls. We will board a glass elevator, which takes us to a platform where more exquisite views will be revealed.

Along with its “sister” park in Argentina, The Iguassu National Park forms the most significant remaining rainforest in the southern cone of South America, which along with the waterfalls have been declared a National Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Return to your hotel with the rest of the day free.

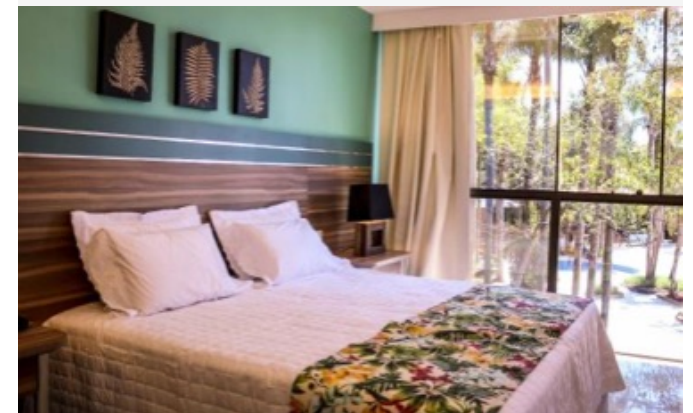

DAY 9

## IGUASSU

### A FULL DAY PRIVATE TOUR OF THE SIDE OF THE ARGENTINE FALLS

You will be picked up early at your hotel in an air conditioned minibus and greeted by your local guide. You will be driven across the border into Argentina (don't forget your passport!) to catch the jungle train. The train travels slowly through the thick jungle and is a great opportunity to spot wildlife. On arrival there are some walkways that lead to a balcony looking right over the Devil's Throat and with panoramic views of the entire Devil's Gorge, one of the most spectacular parts of the falls. You will have plenty of time to walk the 800 metres of paths on the upper circuit. The paths are suspended to protect the vegetation and prevent disruption to the natural trails. This higher circuit affords fantastic views. The lower circuit has 600 metres of walkways with impressive views from below and around the falls. At the end of the day you will be taken back to your hotel.

Begin with an exciting open top truck ride through the jungle along the 8km Yacaratiá trail as your guide informs you about the trails and what to expect on the boat. On arrival to the port there are about 100 steps to get down to the river. From here you will board the motorboats that take you up the lower Iguazú rapids to the heart of the falls. You are given a waterproof bag for your camera because after the photo opportunities you will head right up to the falls. Be prepared to get very wet!

**TOP TIP:** For the boat trip there is an area where you can dry off but you may want to take some spare clothes and a towel in your day pack for extra comfort.

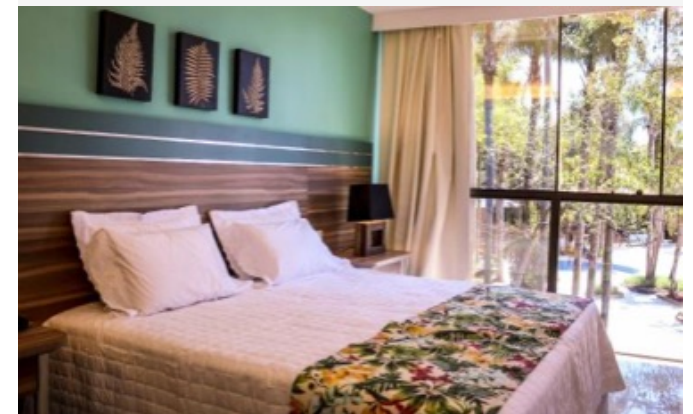

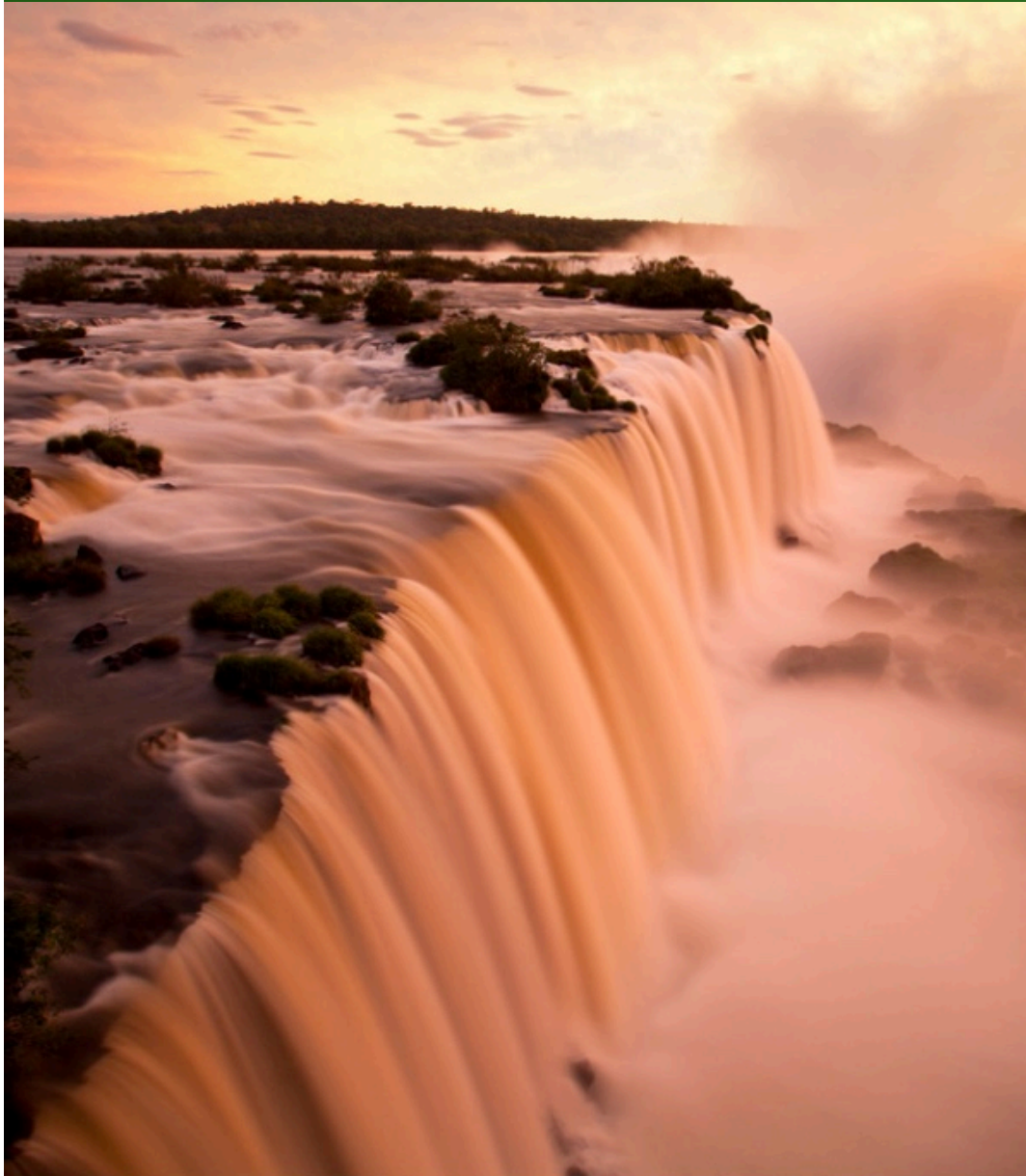

## **SALVADOR**

### **FLY FROM IGUASSU TO SALVADOR VIA SAO PAULO**

Early, private transfer from your hotel to the airport for your flight to Salvador.

On arrival to Salvador you will be met at the airport by your driver who will take you by private transfer to your hotel (about a 40 minute drive). The rest of the day is at leisure.

Located on a triangular peninsular facing the bay of all saints on one side and the Atlantic on the other, Salvador is one of the oldest cities in Latin America originally founded by the Portuguese colonists in 1549. It is the capital of the state of Bahia and has a palpable African influence due to the slaves brought over to work on the sugar plantations. This influences all aspects of Bahian culture and it is where capoeira, the mix of dance and martial art, originated.

The multi-coloured colonial buildings of the Pelourinho are amongst the most impressive on the continent and beyond the city there are miles of perfect beaches to explore.

### A HISTORICAL TOUR OF THE CITY

This tour will introduce you to Salvador City, showing how it has changed throughout the ages to become the Salvador of today. Starting out along the bay, the tour then works its way through Salvador's tree-lined streets up to the Pelourinho, a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site due to its spectacular and well preserved colonial architecture.

Leaving the vehicle behind in the Municipal Square, close to the Lacerda lift, you will continue on foot, accompanied by your guide, where you can appreciate the splendid buildings that take you back in time to the beginnings of this vibrant city. Along the way, you will stop off at the São Francisco Church, with its extravagant gold leaf baroque designs, from there you continue towards the Largo do Pelourinho, at the heart of the neighbourhood.

Return to your hotel after the tour.

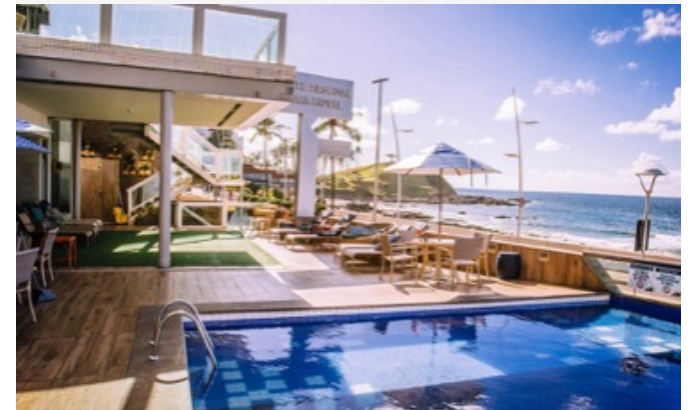

### FREE DAY BEFORE FLYING FROM SALVADOR TO SÃO PAULO

Free time today until a late afternoon transfer to the airport for a flight on to Brazil and indeed, South America's largest city of Sao Paulo.

In arrival a transfer direct to your hotel to overnight.

Sao Paulo is the name of both the city and the surrounding state. Referred to affectionately by the locals as 'Sampa', Sao Paulo city is a giant sprawling metropolis of almost 20 million people making it the largest city in Latin America and one of the biggest in the world.

Although it is not known as the most beautiful city and usually not included on most tourist's itineraries, Sao Paulo offers some of Brazil's best museums, gourmet restaurants, excellent shopping, a thriving arts scene and a few outstanding luxury hotels.

Outside of the city there is a wonderful coastline with some pristine beaches or go inland for rolling hills and rural life on a traditional fazenda.

## **SÃO PAULO**

### **FULL DAY TOUR OF THE CITY WITH PRIVATE CAR & GUIDE**

There is much to see in this vast city of 13.5 million people. We'll begin our walking tour in the beautiful eastern neighbourhood of Liberdade, famous for its typical Japanese decorations. From here we'll continue to Sé Square in the center of town where we'll visit the incredible Sé Cathedral with its splendid windows. We'll then walk to "Patio del Colegio" where the city was founded and we can visit the tower of Banespa (Monday to Friday) to see a panoramic view of the city. We'll then carry on towards the new financial centre of São Paulo (Sao Paulo): Paulista Avenue, the city's biggest road which is full of important buildings, including MASP (Museum of Art of São Paulo), considered one of the best museums in the world. Stop for lunch (meals not included in rate).

In the afternoon we'll continue our São Paulo experience as we visit "Ponte Estaiada" (Octavio Frias de Oliveira Bridge), one of the city's most popular tourist attractions due to its modern architecture. In the wealthy Morumbi neighbourhood we'll see impressive mansions, the Morumbi Stadium (São Paulo FC's stadium) and the Government Palace. Then it's time to visit Ibirapuera Park, an area of over a million square metres full of plants and trees and also home to the Oscar Niemeyer Museum. From here we'll go the Ipiranga Museum and visit the beautiful garden which features a fountain and monument dedicated to Brazil's independence. Our tour finishes in the Municipal Market (closed on Sundays), a beautiful building built in 1933 that is home to the public market where we can find a wide variety of fruits, cheeses, fish, etc.

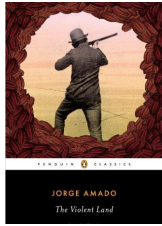

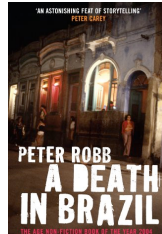






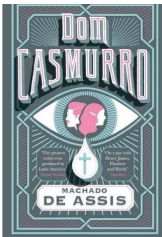
**THE VIOLENT LAND**

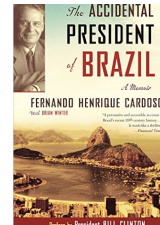

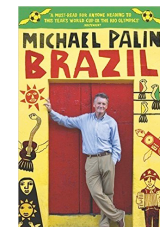
