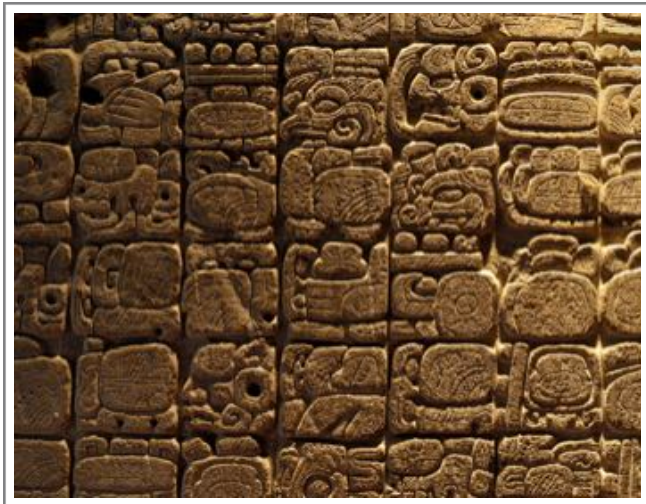

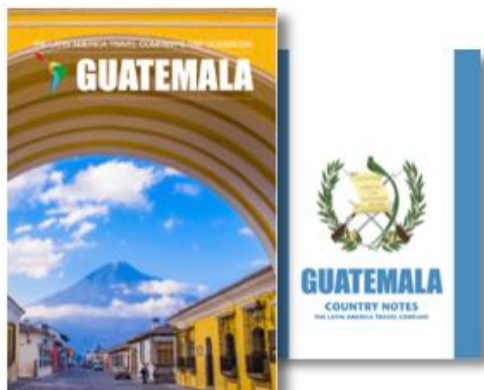

### ANTIGUA

#### MORNING OF MUSEUM VISITS & AFTERNOON TRANSFER TO ANTIGUA

This morning visit three of the city's best museums. Start with the Popol Vuh Museum visit named after the most famous Maya holy text, this museum houses an impressive collection of pre-Columbian art, spread through some six or seven small rooms. The collection includes stone sculpture, multicoloured pottery, incense holders, and even funeral pyres.

Continue to the Ixchel Museum which houses a collection of textiles from approximately 120 indigenous communities, providing a good introduction and history of the textiles of the country. Here the traveler will gain a good perspective for the rest of their journey across de Guatemala. The main collection is made up of pieces of utilitarian and ceremonial clothing used by the indigenous since the late 14th century till today. There is also a collection from Carmen L. Pettersen which is exhibited in the last room. Mrs Pettersen documented in detail the distinctive costumes of various communities.

Lastly, the National Archeology Museum which houses the most important collection of Maya archaeological artefacts in the country. It traces indigenous history over the centuries and through the present day, using several hundred Maya artefacts to tell the story. The highlight of the collection is the jade exhibit, with earrings, bracelets, masks, and an impressive scale model of Tikal.

This afternoon a transfer to Antigua with free time on arrival.

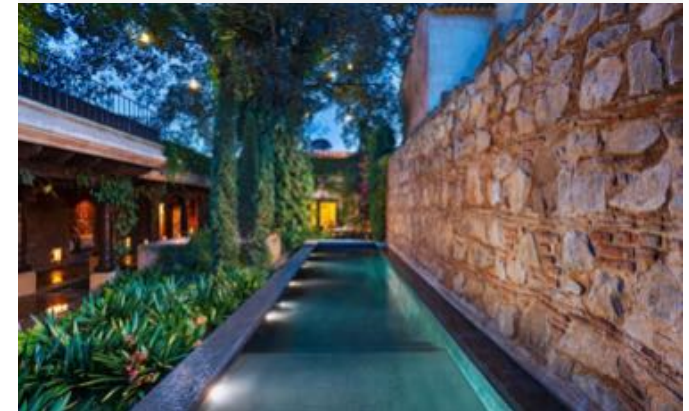

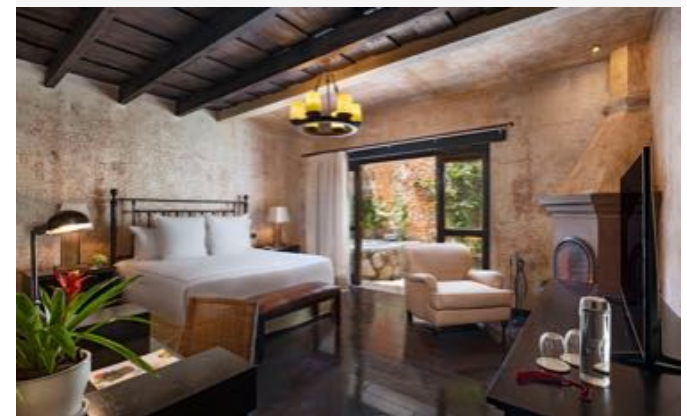
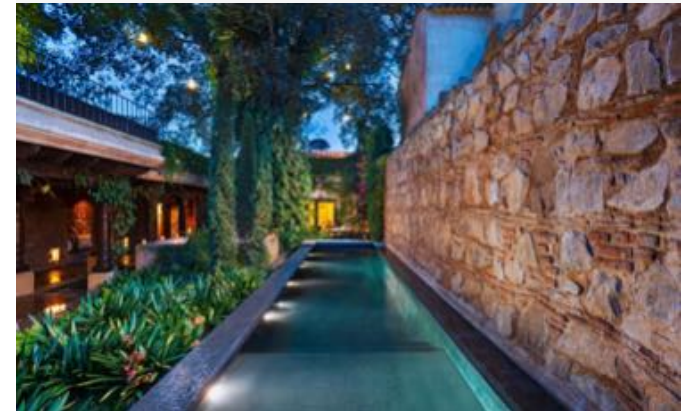

#### IXIMCHE MAYAN SITE VISIT & FREE AFTERNOON

After breakfast a private transfer with your guide will take you to Iximche, a Post Classic Mayan site, located in the Western Highlands of Guatemala. Although it is not the major archaeological site, it was founded by the Kaqchikel Maya in 1,470 after a prolonged conflict with the Quiche.

It was the capital of the Late Pre-classic Kaqchikel kingdom from 1,470 until its abandonment in 1,524 with the Spaniards arrival. On arrival, your guide will show you around the main temples and the history of this fantastic site.

Return to your hotel in Antigua with a free afternoon.

Copan Ruins, often simply called Copán, is a beautiful town paved with cobblestones and lined with white adobe buildings with red tiled roofs. This village became famous when the Mayan ruins were discovered. The Maya have inhabited this valley, which has an aura of timeless harmony, for about 2000 years. Copan has become a primary tourist destination, but this hasn't affected the town's integrity as other towns.

### FULL DAY TOUR TO THE STUNNING COPAN RUINS

Copan is one of the best-restored, interesting, and elaborate Mayan cities known. Occupied between 400 and 800 AD, Copan covers over 50 acres of temples, altars, steles, ball courts, several plazas and the Hieroglyphic Stairway. Located through the beautiful lush and mountainous valley, it features some of the Mayas most impressive accomplishments in architecture, astronomy, and art.

Among the magnificent finds are the well- preserved Rosalila Temple and the tombs of several of Copan's rulers.

You have a comprehensive tour of the Copan archeological site with your guide showing you the layout and main temples.

After the tour returns to your hotel with free time for the rest of the day.

### RIO DULCE

#### VISIT THE QUIRIGUA ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE & TRANSFER TO RIO DULCE

This morning visit the ruins of Quirigüa which retain an impressive series of stele and sculpted calendars, partially deciphered, which constitute a remarkable and unique source of the history of the social, political and economic events of the Mayan civilization.

The zoomorphic and anthropomorphic sculptures are among the most attractive pre-Columbian works known. This small archeological site is one of the 3 UNESCO heritage sites in Guatemala as Tikal and the Colonial city of Antigua.

After the tour a private transfer to your hotel Rio Dulce with the rest of the day free to enjoy the facilities.

### RIO DULCE

#### RIO DULCE CANYON TOUR INCLUDING LIVINGSTONE

The Rio Dulce is a navigable river which begins in Lake Izabal and empties into the Atlantic Ocean. Rio Dulce has become an ideal destination to navigate due to the magical journey through the canyon which was part of the route of commerce of the Mayas. It has a fantastic view when browsing through the cliffs over 300 feet high covered with tropical vegetation. Today you will experience this canyon.

While navigating the Rio Dulce (sweet river) you will cross through "EL Golfete", the wider area of the river in which the Chocon Machaca park and the floating gardens are located. Along the way you will also stop at Ak'Tenamit, a local cooperative that has been able to assist the village in the education and medical services through sustainable methods.

Between "El Golfete" and Livingston, starts an impressive canyon with walls of jungle and limestone. The tour ends at Livingston, the only town in Guatemala in which the Garifunas settle in the 1800s. It has a unique ambiance that you won't find anywhere else in the country. Laid-back and relaxed, Livingston will remind you more of a Caribbean island than of Latin America.

Return to the hotel with the evening free.

### TRANSFER TO FLORES & A YAXHA ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE SUNSET TOUR

After breakfast a private transfer from Rio Dulce to your hotel on Flores which takes around 4 hours.

In the afternoon a private transfer to Yaxha archeological site, an ancient ceremonial centre of Mayan civilisation situated in the northeast of Peten. This site is a mixture of archeology, beautiful landscapes and ecological tourism. With more than 500 structures in the site, including 40 steles, 13 altars and 9 pyramids this site is a must when visiting the area.

On arrival, your guide will show you the layout and main temples and you end the day watching the sunset on top of a pyramid. After sun-down return to your hotel in Flores.

### UAXACTUN ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE & COMMUNITY TOUR

After breakfast a private transfer to the Uaxactun archeological site. Your journey starts at the community entrance in which you will learn about their history and the first settlers. You'll experience a daily life of a member of the Uaxactun community, and how they earn their livelihood.

Then continue on to the archeological site. The Astronomical Observation Complex found in Uaxactún is still very important for the celebration of Maya ceremonies and rituals. Equinoxes and solstices are celebrated every year during the Uaxactún Festival Lunch is included at the house of one of the best cooks in Uaxactun and she will share stories about her family and childhood. She even has a small archeological museum at her house.

After Lunch, you'll be transferred back to the hotel with the rest of the day free.

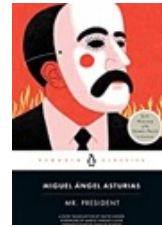
**SILENCE ON THE MOUNTAIN**

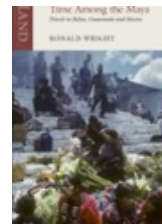
