



ANTIGUA

START YOUR GUATEMALAN ADVENTURE WITH A HIKE UP PACAYA VOLCANO

After breakfast a private transfer to Pacaya volcano. Located just outside the capital of Guatemala City, Pacaya Volcano rises to 2,552m (8,373ft) and is one of three active volcanoes in Guatemala. After a period of dormancy, it's been active since 1965, sometimes more dramatically than other times!

It is about an hour drive from Antigua to the Pacaya National Park and the trailhead in the small village of San Francisco de Sales. The roughly 2 mile trail is relatively steep but well maintained and climbs steadily through farmland and pine forest before arriving on an exposed ridge offering a panoramic view of Pacaya's smoking black cone, miles of old blackened lava flows and the volcanoes to the north around Antigua and Lake Atitlan.

The hike continues onto the barren moonscape of lava flows where you'll be able to roast marshmallows over hot spots for a "smores a la Guatemala!" You'll enjoy a picnic lunch with a view of the crater from afar (National Park regulations do not allow climbing to the top of the crater).

Descend with a transfer back to your hotel in Antigua with he evening to relax.

LAKE ATITLAN

CHICHICASTENANGO MARKET VISIT & TRANSFER TO LAKE ATITLAN

Chichicastenango is home to what is surely the most colourful native market in the Americas. Market days and draw not only the K'iche' Maya of the surrounding region, but vendors from all over Guatemala, representing many of Guatemala's linguistic groups such as Mam, Ixil, Kaqchikel and others.

NOTE: The main market is are held every Sunday and Thursday

On arrival, you will meet your guide who will show you the church which is an important and iconic monument for the indigenous Mayan history itself. If you're lucky you will also witness special ceremonies and mix of religions.

Time for lunch (included) before a private transfer to from Antigua to your hotel at Lake Atitlan which is about a 3 hour drive.

LAKE ATITLAN

BOAT TRIP TO SAN JUAN & SANTIAGO ATITLAN VILLAGES

Private boat to visit San Juan la Laguna and Santiago Atitlan, two very special and different towns on the shores of Lake Atitlan. Santiago is home to Maximon, a venerated pagan saint who smokes tobacco and drinks moonshine (why not!) He resides in a different house each year.

San Juan la Laguna is a bit quieter town, less visited and is home to several textile coops and art galleries and makes for a pleasant wander.

Lunch is included and you will return to your hotel in the afternoon.



KAYAK ON LAKE ATITLAN & FLIGHT ON TO FLORES

After breakfast your guide will meet you at the lobby of your hotel for your boat transfer to the kayak starting point. Paddle for approximate 45 minutes along delightful peninsulas admiring the shore's beautiful gardens. The views are spectacular with three stunning volcanoes, Atitlan, San Pedro, and Toliman possible to see weather permitting. At the end of the kayaking a boat will transfer you back to the hotel.

Private transfer to Guatemala City airport for a flight on to Flores. On arrival in Flores airport a private transfer to your hotel with the rest of the day free.

MONKEY RIVER TOUR A YAXHA ARCHEOLOGICAL SITE SUNSET TOUR

The property in which Las Lagunas hotel is located, has 5 lagoons and the biggest one is called Laguna Quexil. In this lagoon they have two islands and in one of them they breed and take care of monkeys.

Every morning the hotel prepares fresh fruit and vegetables to feed them. You will get to watch them come down from the top of the trees to eat their food and you might even get a chance to feed them.

In the afternoon a private transfer to Yaxha archeological site, an ancient ceremonial centre of Mayan civilisation situated in the northeast of Peten. This site is a mixture of archeology, beautiful landscapes and ecological tourism. With more than 500 structures in the site, including 40 steles, 13 altars and 9 pyramids this site is a must when visiting the area.

On arrival, your guide will show you the layout and main temples and you end the day watching the sunset on top of a pyramid. After sun-down return to your hotel in Flores.

TOUR OF TIKAL NATIONAL PARK & LUNCH IN THE JUNGLE

After breakfast, your guide will meet you at the lobby of your hotel and transfer you to Tikal National Park for a tour of discovery around the temples, architecture, history of this amazing Mayan site.

Learn theories of why the Mayans disappeared and if you are lucky a few monkeys, parrots, macaws, and toucans will be on site to add to the exotic flavour.

After the tour lunch at a restaurant in the middle of the jungle before a transfer back to your hotel. The rest of the day is free before continuing on to Belize tomorrow.



CROSS FROM GUATEMALA TO BELIZE AND THE TOWN OF SAN IGNACIO

A private transfer to the Guatemala border and pass through immigration. From the Guatemalan side of the border you will need to cross on your own to the Belize Border post.

After passing through immigration a different vehicle and driver will meet you on the Belizean side for a private transfer to your hotel in the town of San Ignacio.

The rest of the day is free to relax in the lovely grounds of this resort hotel.

SAN IGNACIO

FULL DAY TOUR TO XUNANTUNICH & CAHAL PECH

After breakfast a private transfer to the Xunantunich Archeological Site. Here you will have a guided tour through the site visiting the most important monuments. The structure called El Castillo rises 130 feet above ground making it one of the highest buildings in Belize, offering an impressive panoramic view of the Mopan River valley. From this structure you will be able to appreciate on a lower temple a large stucco frieze, as well as a mask with larger ears next to a moon sign with a border of signs representing Venus.

Continue on to Cahal Pech which means "place of ticks", in the modern Maya language and refers to the fact that the area was surrounded once by pastureland. During the Classic Period, Cahal Pech was the royal acropolis-palace of an elite Mayan ruling family. Cahal Pech was settled around 1000 BC and abandoned by 800 AD.

The site consists of seven plazas and over 30 structures including temples, residential buildings, ball courts, an altar, and a sweat-house, all situated on just 2 acres. A royal burial chamber was found in one of the structures. Inside the tomb a ruler had been laid to rest with the accourrements necessary for the afterlife. Included in the find were shell & bone ornaments, pottery vessels, obsidian blades, and jade objects, the most impressive being a jade & shell mosaic mask. One of the temples in these small complex commands the best view of the surrounding Belize River Valley.



SAN IGNACIO

A DAY OF ADVENTURE AT THE ATM CAVE COMPLEX

Private transfer to the ATM Cave.

You will hike for 30 minutes through the forest before arriving the cave entrance. A short swim will lead you into the amazing underworld realm. An adventurous trek leads into the main water passage, where you get to enjoy amazing geological formations like sparkling stalactites, stalagmites, and flow stones. This hidden chamber promises to reveal ancient secrets and geological processes that have helped to shape the Maya underworld known as Xibalba; a fearful world beneath the face of the earth; the parallel unseen, into which kings and shamans of the Maya past could venture in to communicate with their gods or ancestors through rituals and ceremonies. Picnic lunch on site.

What to Bring: Light clothing and swim wear, insect repellent, closed-toe footwear (trainers or water shoes with good sole grips recommended), socks, change of clothes & towel. No cameras are allowed in the cave.

- Passengers are permitted one check-in hold piece with maximum weight of 20 lb / 9 kg and up to 22 inches / 12 inches / 12 inches (60cm/35cm/35cm)
- Passengers are permitted one carry-on piece with a maximum weight of 10 lb / 4.5 Kg with a size up to 16 inches / 9 inches (42cm/ 24cm)

NOTE: The Passenger must pay USD 1 per each additional 1 lb (0.45kg) of weight over 20 lb / 9 kg. This is payable at the airport on checkin.

Belize Domestic Luggage Policy:

- Passengers are permitted one check-in hold piece with maximum total dimensional size limit of 62 linear inches (157cm) with the width limited to 30 inches (76cm) and the height to 15 inches (38cm). Weight of the bag is not important but bags larger than this cannot be transported.
- Passengers are permitted one carry-on piece with a maximum weight of 15 lb / 6.8 Kg which must fit on your lap.






THE BEAST
