ARRIVE IN CANCUN & TRANSFER TO YOUR HOTEL IN VALLADOLID

Welcome to Mexico! Today you will be met at the airport by your representative and taken to your hotel for check in. The rest of the day is free for you to start exploring this incredible city.

For the next 2 nights you will be staying in Valladolid, a short drive away from Chichén Itzá. Valladolid was founded in the 1500's by Spaniards on an earlier Mayan settlement known as Zaci (which means 'white hawk' in Mayan), and quickly became an important religious centre.

VALLADOLID

EXCURSION TO EK-BALAM, CENOTE & EXPLORE VALLADOLID

This morning you will start your guided tour by driving to the archaeological site of Ek Balam. Ek-Balam means "bright star jaguar" or "black jaguar" in the Mayan language.

The main temple is impressive, both in size and architecture. The most striking temple is one with a huge monster mouth. To the Mayan's this represented the portal to the underworld. The sculpted works of the Mayan ruins at Ek Balam are unusual and extremely well preserved. Some figures are winged, some in the meditative lotus position, one sits headless above the centre of the monster mouth.

After your tour you will visit a Cenote and will have time to swim in the refreshing waters. To finish, you will visit the Magic Town of Valladolid. There are seven colonial churches and the city is nicknamed the "Sultan of the East" because of its colonial splendour. Head southwest of the park and main plaza to arrive at the 16th century Ex Convent of San Bernardino de Siena, it is one of the most beautiful buildings in Valladolid. Inside the church there are some original frescos and housed within the walls of the Convent building there are some orchards, and gardens.

Return your hotel after your tour where the remainder of the day is at leisure.

JOURNEY TO MERIDA VIA THE SUPERB CHICHEN ITZA RUINS

Today will start with one of the highlights of your trip - A guided tour of Chichén Itzá, one of the 7 Wonders of the World. Chichén Itzá is the best restored of Yucatan's Mayan sites and one of the most striking & imposing in the world.

With your guide, you will explore the magnificent ruins set in a dense jungle, including the Pyramid of Kukulcan – its height and striking geometric design dominating the whole site, the Great Ball Court – the largest and most impressive in Mesoamerica, the Sacred Cenote – a natural well used for human sacrifice, and many other beautiful temples.

After some time exploring the ruins you will continue to Izamal, around 90 minutes from Chichén Itzá. In ancient times, Izamal was a centre for the worship of the supreme Mayan god, Itzamna, and the sun god, Kinich-Kakmo. A dozen temple pyramids were devoted to these gods. These bold expressions of religion are possibly why the Spanish colonists chose Izamal as the site for an enormous Franciscan monastery, the Convento de San Antonio de Padua, which today stands at the heart of the town.

You will also visit the impressive monastery, the Mayan ruins, and the streets of this quiet, colonial gem, nicknamed “La Ciudad Amarilla” (the yellow city) for the traditional yellow that most buildings are painted in. After your tour you will continue to Merida where you will be dropped at your hotel for check in.

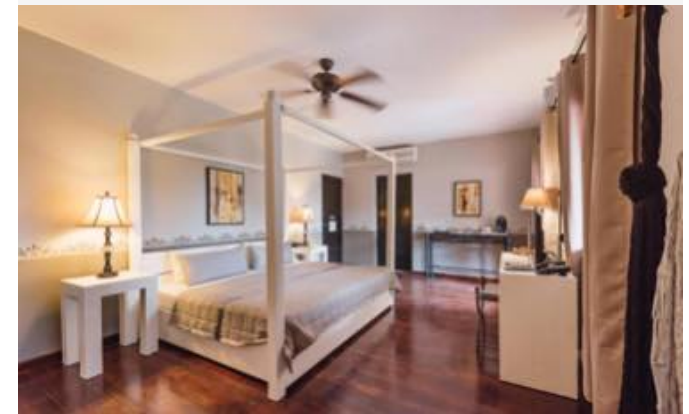

DELICIOUS STREET-FOOD WALKING TOUR OF MERIDA

Start your walking tour with a visit to the local central market Lucas de Galvez, where you will have an introduction to the local products and their use in traditional dishes. You will taste some local delicacies such as empanadas, polcanes, panuchos or salbutes and cochinita pibil tacos.

Following your market visit, the tour will continue with a walk in the zocalo where you will go to a restaurant where you will taste a variety of seafood tacos.

Finish the tour with a visit to a local Ice Cream stand to taste the traditional ice creams made of local fruits.

The remainder of the day is free for you to continue your exploration of the city independently.

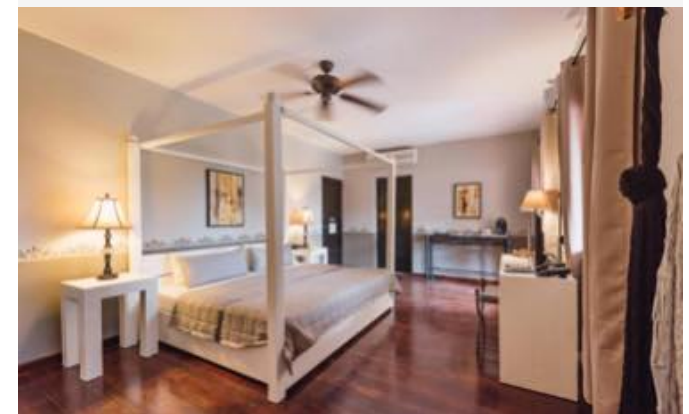

CELESTUN

A FULL DAY EXCURSION TO CELESTUN TO SEE PINK FLAMINGOES

Today, you and your guide will drive to the quaint fishing village of Celestun, located 90km west of Merida.

The Celestun Biosphere Reserve is home to 587 plant species, 42 of which are endemic. The fauna found in the reserve include 304 bird species, including the famous Mexican pink flamingo, least tern, jabiru, king vulture and greater white-fronted goose. There are also 75 mammals and 64 reptile species.

Your guide will take you on a boat ride through the estuaries to observe the beautiful pink flamingo colonies and other birds. We will make a stop at fresh water springs where the water is sweet, transparent and ideal for swimming.

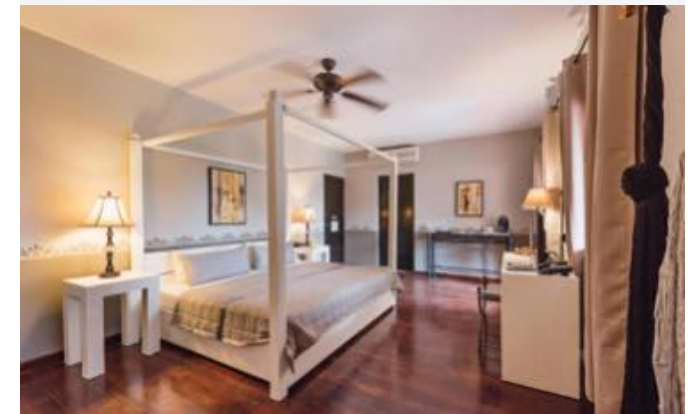

JOURNEY TO UXMAL VIA THE YAXCOPOIL ESTATE

This morning your tour will start with a drive to Yaxcopoil, a restored 17th-century hacienda just outside of Merida. This vast estate grew and processed henequen, and many of its numerous French Renaissance-style buildings have been lovingly restored.

With your guide, you will explore the superb interiors, and then drive (30min) to the Mayan ruins of Uxmal. This Unesco World Heritage Site is considered the finest and most extensively excavated example of Puuc architecture, which embraces such details as ornate stone mosaics and soaring vaulted arches.

You will have time to explore the magnificent buildings and then have lunch at a local restaurant. On the drive from Uxmal back to Merida, you will time to stop at the turquoise “cenote” (water sinkhole) of Sambulá. Cenotes were sacred to the Mayan people because they represented the entrance to the underworld, and many valuable artefacts and even human skeletons have been found in them

After your visit, you will be taken to your hotel in Uxmal for check-in.

JOURNEY TO THE STUNNING BEACHES OF TULUM

Today you will meet your driver at your hotel for the drive to Tulum, the only walled city the Mayan's built and the only one by the edge of the Caribbean. When the Spanish first came upon the site in 1518, they recorded that it was as large as Seville. The major construction is the Castle, a handsome pyramid perched on the edge of a cliff high above the pearl-white beaches below. From here one can see most of the ancient city, as well as a magnificent view of the coastline.

On arrival in Tulum, you will have plenty of time to enjoy your hotel and its surroundings. Tulum is well known for its picturesque beaches, laid back towns and ancient ruins.

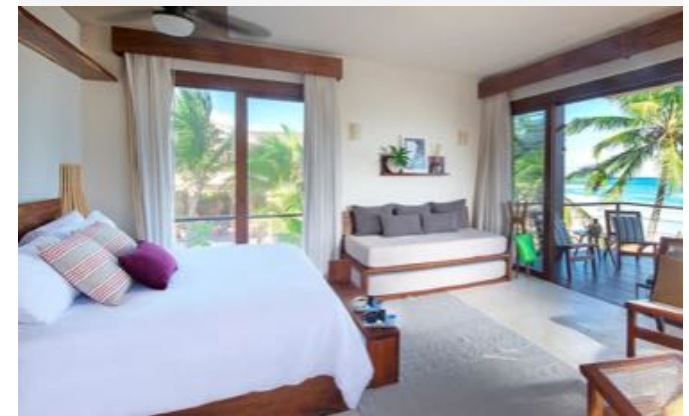

FREE DAY TO RELAX AT THE BEACH

Today is a day at leisure in the beautiful Tulum. The area is well known for its spectacular beaches and your hotel has plenty of facilities to enjoy.

For decades, the attraction of ancient Mayan energies in combination with the magic of historic sites and natural wonders has brought spiritually-centred tourism to the area. Tulum is now a bustling tourist destination. It was once a peaceful beach town, home to artists and yogis. Although modern amenities and luxury hotels are available, you still have the Mayan spirit to explore. Between the thirteenth century and the fifteenth century, Tulum was the last great Mayan city built and inhabited. It was a place of worship to the Great Descending God, whose image is displayed in the temples. The great wall that surrounds the city is believed to have been built to keep out pirates and envious traders who sought to seize the location.

Please do let us know if you would like to add on any excursions in the area. We would particularly recommend a visit to the UNESCO World Heritage site of Tulum, famed for its ancient ruins overlooking the sea.

Today is a final free day at leisure in Tulum. However, as well as the fabulous beach for those looking for some adventure there are the Cenotes.

 **Meals Included:** Breakfast.



Cenotes are a natural pit, or sinkhole, resulting from the collapse of limestone bedrock that exposes groundwater. The regional term is specifically associated with the Yucatán Peninsula of Mexico, where cenotes were commonly used for water supplies by the ancient Maya, and occasionally for sacrificial offerings. The term derives from a word used by the lowland Yucatec Maya—ts'onot—to refer to any location with accessible groundwater. Nowadays some are accessible and can be explored by divers or just swimming in their often crystal clear waters.

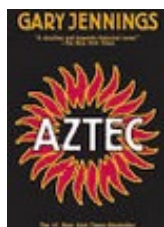

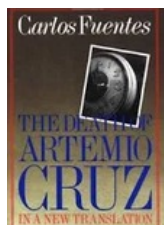

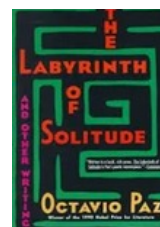
