#### FLIGHT TO MEDELLIN

Continue to the Ethnographic Museum of the Amazonian Man where you will get to appreciate a collection of objects and utensils used by the indigenous culture of the region. Finally, your guide will continue to Tabatinga in Brazil by taxi or tuc tuc with time for shopping in the handicraft stores.

Following your tour, your guide will take you to the airport for your flight to Medellin which will likely go via Bogota.

On arrival, your new driver will meet you and transfer you to your hotel where the rest of the day is free for you to enjoy the city. Your hotel is located in the El Poblado neighbourhood which is very peaceful and quiet but close to the commercial area where you will find a wide variety of shops and restaurants.

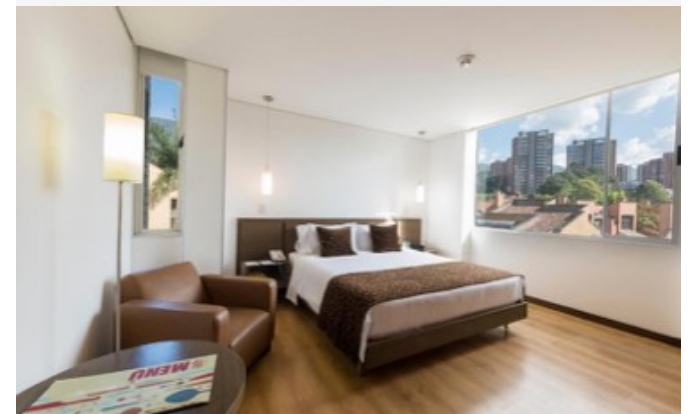

In the past, Medellin was one of the most dangerous cities in South America but has undergone a radical transformation to become a city of peace and social change. Your guide will take you to the Santo San Javier barrio, which used to be one of the most unsafe neighbourhoods of the city. However, after the death of Pablo Escobar, the barrio has completely changed and is now a very pleasant place to visit. The metro cable car is a great way to see incredible views over the city.

Your tour will also visit Comuna 13 where you can see some incredible graffiti which makes the neighbourhood famous and symbolises the expression of the community.

The trip finishes in the district of La Plazoleta that houses 23 sculptures of Fernando Botero. After your tour, your guide will drop you off for your flight to Cartagena.

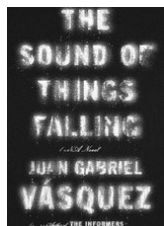
**LOVE IN THE TIME OF CHOLERA**

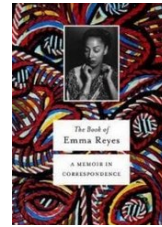
**THE SOUND OF THINGS FALLING**

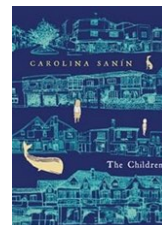
**MOTHER TONGUE: A BOGOTAN STORY**

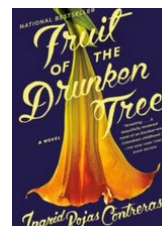
**THE CHILDREN**
