





You begin with a tour of the bohemian neighbourhood of Barranco, the artists corner of Lima with its colourful republican houses, grand colonial mansions and intriguing cultural history. Home to writers, photographers and artists, Barranco is full of galleries and museums. You will visit the Puente de los suspiros which is a bridge where partners have left padlocks as a homage to their love. You will also visit the main square and admire the views of the ocean.

After this you continue to Casa Aliaga which is the oldest continuously inhabited colonial mansion in the Southern hemisphere. The same family still live there to this day and inside there is an interesting collection of paintings and other art.

Finally you will visit the impressive Santo Domingo convent, an architectural masterpiece that houses a collection of paintings and relics of Peruvian saints.

Lunch in a local restaurant is included before returning to your hotel.





AREQUIPA

CITY TOUR WITH THE SANTA CATALINA MONASTERY & JUANITA MUMMY

This morning you will be met at your hotel by your private local guide and driver for your half day guided tour of Arequipa, the Ciudad blanca (white city). We begin with a visit to the extraordinary Santa Catalina Monastery which was originally founded in 1579 by a small group of clergy. Your private guide will take you on a tour of the extensive buildings which also contain one of the largest holdings of colonial art in the Americas. We continue the tour to the magnificent Iglesia de la Compañia de Jesús. This church has a beautiful Baroque facade and is meticulously decorated inside with coloured murals.

After spending some time in the church we continue to the Mirador del Carmen, a natural lookout point ten minutes drive outside of the city centre. From here we can enjoy a spectacular view of the Chili River Valley, the city and El Misti volcano rising behind. From here we move onto the upmarket neighbourhood of Yanahuara to see it's old ashlar stone mansions, cobbled streets and a beautiful church dating from 1750. After the tour you will be dropped back at your hotel or you can ask to be dropped at a restaurant for lunch.

SUGGESTION: After the tour ask to be dropped at the Zig Zag restaurant for lunch - a fantastic affordable Peruvian restaurant with excellent reviews housed in an attractive two-story colonial house. It is also only a short walk from your hotel.

UCUSCO

A TOUR OF CUSCO & THE NEARBY RUINS WITH A PRIVATE GUIDE

This morning you will be picked up at your hotel after breakfast to begin the half day tour of Cusco, the imperial Inca city, accompanied by your private local guide. You start the tour at one of the most impressive buildings in the historic centre of Cusco, the Qoricancha (golden temple).

At the time of the Inca empire this temple was dedicated to the worship of the Sun God and the interior walls were once completely covered in gold. From here you stroll through Cusco's main plaza and visit the impressive cathedral which contains an exquisite collection of 17th and 18th century paintings by the Cusco school of painters.

After this you drive slightly outside of the city to the nearby ruins of Tambomachay, an old Inca system of aqueducts and canals. You also visit Quenko, a religious site where sacrifices and mummification took place, and Puka Pukara the red fortress. End the tour by visiting the spectacular Sacsayhuaman, an ancient citadel built using enormous stones carved and fitted together tightly without mortar. From here there is also a good view over Cusco.

After the tour you will be returned to your hotel.

MACHU PICCHU

A CLASSIC TRAIN JOURNEY & PRIVATE TOUR OF ICONIC MACHU PICCHU

After breakfast in your hotel you will be picked up and taken by private transfer to Poroy train station to begin your journey to Machu Picchu on board the luxury Hiram Bingham train. The Hiram Bingham train features large windows on the side and a stylish observatory car to enjoy the breathtaking scenery. The journey through the Urubamba valley takes around 4 hours before arriving at Aguas Calientes. A gourmet lunch is served on board and there is live entertainment along the way.

On arrival you will be met by your private local guide who will accompany you on the bus which takes you up the mountain to the Machu Picchu archeological site (30 minute bus journey). Hidden in the Eastern Andes mountains, the Holy City of Machu Picchu is an extraordinary example of ancient Inca architecture and engineering. Built in a seemingly impossible location on the side of a jagged mountain Machu Picchu is an iconic sight. Your private local guide will show you around the citadel and explain to you it's intriguing and mysterious history. A buffet lunch in a restaurant at the site is included. After the tour you have some free time to further explore the site before you are taken by bus back down the mountain to Aguas Calientes and transferred to your hotel. Dinner is included at your hotel.

NEED TO KNOW: Due to limited storage space on the train each person is only allowed to take one small backpack. This means for tonight when you stay in Aguas Calientes you will only have access to this bag. The remainder of your luggage will be transferred from your hotel in Cusco to your hotel in the Sacred Valley and it will be there waiting for you when you arrive the following day.

Today we have included a second entrance ticket to Machu Picchu so you have the opportunity to explore the site once more independently. Those with moderate fitness and who are not afraid of heights can choose to climb Huayna Picchu for excellent panoramic views of the entire site. If you would like to climb Huayna Picchu please let us know in advance because we would need to get you a permit. Permits are limited and in some cases they may be sold out for that day. For Huayna Picchu we would also need to book one of two daily slots, either 07:00am or 10:00am.

In the afternoon take the luxury Hiram Bingham train for the 2 hour journey to Ollantaytambo station in the Sacred Valley. You will enjoy a delicious gourmet dinner on board and a live music show. ■ SACRED VALLEY

PRIVATE TOUR OF MARAS, MORAY & OLLANTAYTAMBO

After breakfast you will be met at your hotel by your private guide and vehicle for the day to begin exploring three of Sacred Valley's most iconic sites. You begin by visiting Salinas de Maras (the salt ponds of Maras). This is a salt mine that has been in use since the time of Incas and is still in operation today. These ancient salt ponds are terraced down the side of the mountain and create a striking image. Your guide will explain the history of these fascinating ponds and how they are still used today.

After this you continue to the archeological site of Moray. This is a system of impressive circular terraces that descend down 150 metres. The special shape of the terraces create a temperature difference between the top and the bottom of as much as 15 degrees centigrade. Therefore it is thought they were used by the Incas as a testing ground for different crops.

After lunch at a local restaurant you continue to Ollantaytambo, one of the last Inca towns. You will visit the grand fortress and large archeological site which was used by the Incas as a travellers inn for royal delegations on long journeys. There are several impressive stone structures and multiple walls and towers that were used to protect the citadel.








THE CONQUEST OF THE INCAS

JOHN HEMMING



MARIO VARGAS LLOSA


